

The advantages of correspondence and evening education at the University

Student correspondence or evening Department requires the ability to concentrate on the task at hand, a large amount of material to study independently and intelligently allocate time between work and study. Otherwise, the student has every chance to pass the session.

Students of evening and correspondence departments deliberately refuse a carefree student life full of parties, parties and outings.
